Kris Fiore has been the Head Boys Volleyball Coach at Lincoln-Way East H.S. since 2009 and was the Head Girls coach from 2016-2022. Kris's coaching career began at South Hamilton High School in Iowa after playing multiple years for the Iowa State University Men's Club team.

Coach Fiore has won more than 600 matches as a head coach, including state titles in 2014 and 2018, and he was named National Boys Volleyball Coach of the Year by Volleyballmag.com in 2018. Fiore's volleyball playing career began at Lincoln-Way where he was an All-State outside hitter and a member of the first Lincoln-Way team to take home a state trophy.
